Licensed Electrician's Theory (LET) Licensing Tutorial

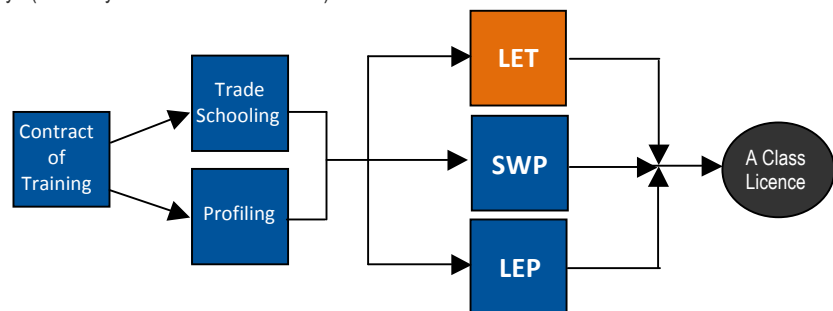
Course Summary and Content

This course prepares the participant for the LET licensing assessment. Topics include:

- Electrical safety
- AS/NZS3000, AS/NZS3008:1.1, AS/NZS3012, AS/NZS4836:2011
- Electrical Safety (Installations) Regulations – 2009
- Voltage Drop
- Maximum demand
- Residual current devices, Multiple Earthed Neutral (MEN) system of earthing
- SELV, PELV and earth leakage current protection
- Protection against overload and short-circuit current

Course Duration and Mode of Study

Four days (weekdays and weekends offered).



Course Requirements/Prerequisites

Apprentices must have successfully completed their off-the-job studies relevant to the Certificate III in Electrotechnology – Systems Electrician. Participants are required to attend with their protective footwear, eyewear and clothing and will need to bring a pen, and calculator. The following books are required on the first day of the course and can be purchased from the NECA Skills Centre. Please note that the latest edition of any standard includes relevant amendments.
