1942

The company was established during the Second World War with a £394 War Loan and an idea built around the use of PVC - a new material coming into commercial use

1947

12 employees were producing **plastic cane, belting and piping** at the rate of 26 tonnes per year. Annual turnover reached £12,000



1957

We moved to **Hastings, East Sussex** - where we are still based today

1970

We made our formal entry into the **cable management** market and started selling conduit

1962

The **Charlotte Marshall Charitable Trust** was formed by Harold Cirket to support UK charities

1971

The name '**Marshall-Tufflex**' was registered

1974

Turnover broke the **£1,000,000** barrier and the company was securing a name for **innovative, high quality products and good customer service** - a reputation we uphold to this day

1976

The **Mini Trunking** design was patented and launched. It was a huge success, transforming the re-wiring and refurbishment procedures of the time

1982-84

We opened a branch in **Blackhorse Lane, Walthamstow**

A branch in **Manchester** opened, to be used as the main stock holding location



1994

An exciting year for Marshall-Tufflex - we started using **recycled material** in our manufacturing process

2006

Odyssey trunking was launched, bringing to market the only all-curved three compartment trunking profile

Marshall-Tufflex **acquired the Bendex brand** - essential cable management, affordably priced

2011

The **Catherine Cirket Discretionary Trust** was established to support the health and welfare of employees and their relatives

2012

A **collection service** was launched allowing customers to collect from Manchester, Watford and Hastings

2014

Awarded **Best Customer Service, Best Overall Supplier and Best New Product** at the Electrical Wholesaler Awards

2016

Sterling Curve was launched - a sleek, curved update to the market leading Sterling range

2019

A year of change with the London warehouse relocated to Watford and head office moved to Castleham, Hastings

2020

Recorded an average of **74% recycled material** across the PVC-U product range

Produced enough conduit to stretch from Hastings to India

Supplied trunking to **NHS Nightingale** hospitals up and down the country in response to the Covid19 pandemic
