STEM Ambassadors – as a STEM Ambassador (STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) you could hold a career talk or practical workshop for a primary or secondary school, college or youth/community organisation.

Speakers for Schools – this initiative arranges careers talks, plus virtual and real-life work experience placements or online projects.

Become an online mentor - in just 45 mins you could hold an online mentoring session via the Youth Group's 'Mentor Me' programme and make a real difference to a young person interested in the electrical industry.
